- ✓ **Junior/Senior**
- ✓ **On track for graduation**
- ✓ **16 or older**
- ✓ **Have a job and reliable transportation**

### CRITERIA:

- **2024-2025 school year**
- **Attendance requirements**
- **On track to graduate**
- **Have a career goal**
- **Able to provide your own transportation.**
- **Job by the first day of school (See FAQ)**
- **Can be a paid or unpaid job (Internship)**

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

### **Do I have to have a job?**

Yes, you should have a job by the first week of school. It can be paid or unpaid. However, due to current circumstances, we can be flexible.

### **Can you help me find a job?**

Yes. If I get information about companies that are hiring, I will pass it on to you. Ultimately it is your responsibility to find a job.

### **Do I need a car?**

You should have reliable transportation and a driver's license OR a reliable person who will take you to work. **You must leave the building during your WBL period.**

### **How many periods of Work-Based can I do?**

Up to 2 class periods

### **Do I have to work everyday?**

No, but you must work at least 5-15 hours/week for each period class of WBL, and you must leave campus.

### **Can I do Dual Enrollment and Work-Based Learning?**

YES! They are a perfect match, since we only meet once a month. You don't have to be on campus (LHS) every day for WBL.
