



Why is it **IMPORTANT** to continue taking a World Language in high school?

1. Learning a World Language helps you to communicate and connect with other cultures. It gives you a competitive advantage in today's world.
2. An Honors World Language course, *(a skills-based one)*, is a non-traditional honors course. Its workload is smaller outside of class when compared to traditional honors courses. We practice the language skills in class daily.
3. Quality Points:
 - a) .5 quality point towards your LHS weighted GPA for Honors Level 3
 - b) 1.0 quality point towards your LHS weighted GPA for Honors Level 4 and above
4. It counts towards the HOPE Scholarship GPA
5. Qualify for scholarships.
6. Possible \$\$\$ savings at some colleges through a placement test or AP credit. Look into the specific college of your choice.
7. Qualify to earn the Georgia's Seal of Biliteracy Seal and/ or the International Skills Diploma Seal on your high school diploma.
